Otis has dreams of becoming the fastest runner on his team, fast enough to earn a place in the Junior Olympics, just like his idol Carl Lewis. But he also must deal with bullies at school, a dad who's often absent, and a neighborhood full of pressure to deal or use. When his dad gifts him a pair of brand-new Air Jordans, Otis thinks the shoes are the key to becoming fast enough to realize his dreams. But when he wakes up one morning to find the shoes are gone, he must face up to the reality that maybe there are more important things than being the fastest runner. (Grades 6 & up)

They claimed these rappings were messages from the spirit world and that they could communicate back. As word of their spooky gift spread, the sisters became instant celebrities. Their older sister, Leah, stepped in as their manager to handle their booming careers as professional mediums. But with fame came a wave of skeptics. Everyone wanted to know whether the Fox sisters were talking to the dead, or whether the whole thing was an epic, choreographed hoax. (Grades 7 & up)

As far back as anyone can remember, the women of the Strand family have been magical. Their gifts manifest at fifteen, always differently. Nell's mother's age changes daily. Her sister bleeds music. Nell sees how magic tears her family apart. When Nell's magic arrives as ladybugs on her piano keys, she feels joy—until the rest come. Beetles crawl up her collarbone when her teacher stares. Moths appear and die with disappointment. Worst are the wasps, surfacing no matter how deep she buries her rage. Nell must decide either to lock herself away to stop them or find the strength to feel everything, no matter the consequences. (Grades 9 & up)

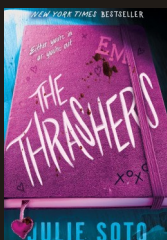


## THE THRASHERS
