At her epic battle against Athena, she does not simply boast of her skills, but calls out the heinous crimes of the gods and men. New perspectives of classic myths woven into this novel-in-verse makes the story even more captivating. (Grades 7 & up)

This fourth and final installment of the American Royals series finds the Washington siblings struggling to find their footing. Queen Beatrice is not only trying to recover from an accident, but also hiding the full extent of the accident's effects from her political rivals. Princess Samantha returns from her tropical escape to find that her position has changed drastically in her absence. And Jefferson has rushed into a role and an engagement that he's not so sure he wants. Are the royal siblings' destinies predetermined, or can they carve out the futures they want on their own terms?
